-  Be bilingual/bicultural (Spanish/English) and/or committed to working with the Latino community

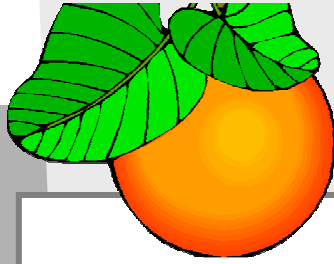
To apply for a scholarship:

-  Present proof of California residence or Orange County, California residence. [For example, a photocopy of your California driver's license or California ID card.]
-  Present proof of acceptance/attendance at any ALA-accredited institution. [For example, a photocopy of your letter of acceptance, a list of current classes or an unofficial copy of your transcript.]
-  Include a personal statement of at least 500 words. [The statement should be typed, double-spaced, and include information about your background that is relevant to the scholarship goals and a description of your commitment to working with the Latino community.]

Note: Scholarship awards are to be applied to school expenses. The number and the amount of each scholarship will be determined by available funds. A committee of chapter members' reviews applications and winners are announced at the August 2010 chapter meeting.
